R v JD (2013) Baby- shaking case. Mother accused of allowing her partner to injure her 16-month-old baby causing a subdural haematoma (Wolverhampton CC).

R v GV (2013): Defendant accused of ritual killing. Burning her husband alive
(Wolverhampton CC)

R V C (2013) Defendant accused of incitement. Member of KKK.

Reported Cases

R v N Hussain (2009) EWCA Crim 2256: Appellant convicted of murder, burning house where 9 members of a family perished. Appeal on contamination.
